Boston College (10 - 3 - 0) - BC is an enigma. While they weren't close to National Championship material, their three losses came by a total of 12 points. In fact, eight of their games were decided by a touchdown or less. On offense, BC does not have great rushing speed so they move the ball primarily behind the arm of QB Matt Ryan. While not spectacular, it is the offense that keeps the Eagles close in games. The defense may only allow 15 points per game but they have an unfortunate tendency of allowing opponents to hang on to possession of the football for extended periods of time. Their main enigma is the kicking situation. Kicker Ryan Ohliger was suspended twice for violations. Field Goal duties were taken over by walk-on Steve Aponavicius who kicked a 37-yard field goal on the final play of the Meineke Car Care Bowl and the Eagles beat the Navy Midshipmen 25-24. Ohliger was replaced by former high school soccer player Steve Aponavicius, a walk-on who had never before played organized football and became something of a cult hero on campus.
