**BROOKFIELD, 1962...** RECORD: 0-9-0 (Last Place NCMC) NOTES: The Bulldogs came into the season with a 9 game losing streak and ended the season with an 18 game losing streak. The streak would hit 20 games before it ended. The highlights of the season are few and far between but there were at least a couple. First, the Dogs proved that nice guys finish last. Over the course of 9 games, the Blue & White were penalized 290 yards, or 32.2 per game, while their 9 opponents were flagged for a whopping 795 yards, or 88.3 per game! But the advantage didn't help the Dogs win a game. The other highlight for Brookfield was Jack Faught. Faught had more speed than any man on the team and was able to run down several opposing ball carriers to save certain touchdowns. On the downside, the offense was almost non-existent while the defense, save Faught's heroics, was as porous as they come. The Special Teams were another problem area for the Dogs as they had 5 punts and an extra point blocked and fumbled the snap on two more punt attempts. The '62 Bulldogs are the worst team in BHS history and, quite possibly, in Linn County history, although the '69 Marceline Tigers would give them a run for their money.
