COLGATE, 1932... RECORD: 9-0-0 (Unscored upon) NOTES: The Red Raiders tore through 9 opponents scoring 264 points while not allowing any. Victories over NYU, Syracuse, Penn St. and 5 other opponents put the undefeated Raiders into a Thanksgiving Day showdown with undefeated Brown for the title of "Best in the East". Colgate won it easily, 21-0. Sitting at 9-0-0 without having allowed a point all season, the team prepared themselves for a Rose Bowl invitation to play undefeated USC on New Year's Day. The invitation never came. USC went on to dismantle Pittsburgh while the Red Raiders were left to ponder what might have been.
